(Optional) Tips & Suggestions for Teachers		
-difference between Urdu and Arabic kasrah and dhamma sounds - explain tajweed of ر (heavy with fathah and dhamma; thin sounding with kasra) - Review 6 throat letters - explain why alif was also shown with throat letters - anytime there is a sign on alif, it is not alif but hamza - only blank alifs are true alifs. (Tell them this info will be used later)		
(Optional) Ideas that may be offered to mothers to make it easier/fun to teach kids		
- Start teaching children early. - Children often learn the entire English alphabet before they are even two years old just by watching educational TV programs. - Children learn willingly and faster when they find the lessons fun, interesting and short.
